- ◆ He wears masks, safety glasses and earplugs.

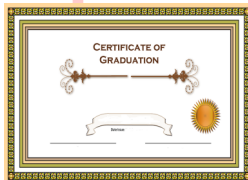
## How did Zane become a tradesperson?

- Became a registered apprentice and started the 4 year program for Carpenter

- Learned on-the-job (1600 hours)
- Earned wages
- Took classes (10 weeks) and completed Level 1

2017

- Started Level 2 and learned on-the-job (1600 hours)
- Earned wages
- Took classes (8 weeks) and completed Level 2



2018

- Started Level 3 and learned on-the-job (1600 hours)
- Earned wages
- Took classes (8 weeks) and completed Level 3

2019

- Started Level 4 and learned on-the-job (1600 hours)
- Earned wages
- Took classes (8 weeks)
- Wrote and passed the Red Seal exam and completed Level 4



2020

- Zane becomes a registered Carpenter journeyman.
